## SLP 2023 BALLMER REPORT

In the inaugural week, our summer learning program conducted student evaluations on pivotal questions, showcasing an initial consensus. Notable, only six students expressed strong disagreement. A follow-up in the sixth week revealed a significant shift, with only three dissenting students, highlighting a remarkable convergence of viewpoints over the program's duration.

The attendance data for our summer learning program may exhibit skewness due to the presence of three concurrent programs within the same facility, all targeting enrollment from the identical pool of district students. Despite these challenges, we are committed to refining our strategies for improved attendance tracking and program effectiveness.

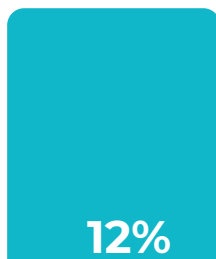
Our proposed academic outcomes focus on achievement targets in key areas 3rd grade English Language Arts (ELA), 4th grade math.

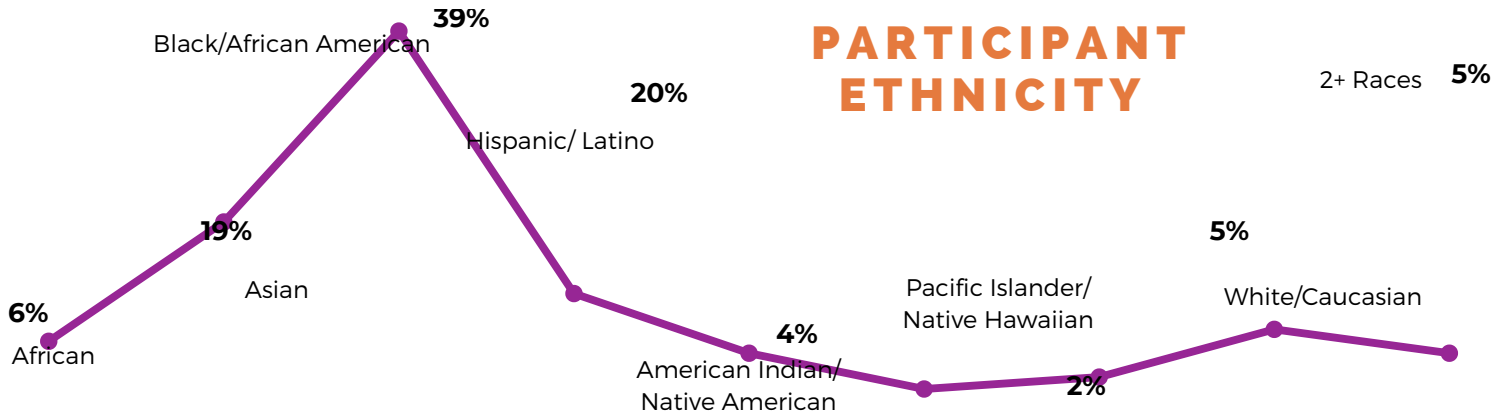

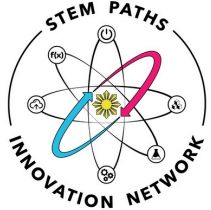
